We have had a huge amount of expenditure over Feb/Mar period this year. Namely: Pathway - £13,053.60 Curtains - £1,920.00 Electrician for toilet sensor - £80.00 Fire Alarm Check - £184.20 Plumbing to change taps - £550.00 Committee room ceiling - £612.00 Scrubbing Machine - £268.80 Fire doors - £3918.00 Totalling - £20,583.00 However we still have £5539.51 in the account with outstanding totalling £1611.75 so potentially £7151.26 at the end of March. This will cover our latest electricity bill of £1500. This was high as it included the panto weeks, the cost of this was around £800. We therefore still have a healthy balance of over £5000. The savings account now stands at £7236. We are now covering cleaning costs which will be around £230 a month and we have the invoice from the local handyman to cover. He is going to do the alterations on the playpark that have been flagged up. The cafe and toddler group are bringing in a good profit to over £100 a week now and we are going to be busy with weekend parties during the spring. Correspondence -
